All of these books have themes of friendship and overcoming bullying. For this assignment, you will complete two Venn Diagrams.

For the first diagram, compare yourself to any one of the characters. Some questions to help you as compare yourself to the character include:

- Are you both friendly?
- Do you have the same personalities, likes, or interests?
- How have you reacted when you have been treated unkindly?
- How have you reacted when you have seen someone being bullied?

The second Venn Diagram will compare and contrast two characters from different books--one character from one of the chapter books above and one character from one of the graphic novels. In addition to the questions from the first Venn Diagram, some phrases you may want to consider as you write your diagram are:
